
Top Free Blu-ray Burner Review and Download

This guide aims to offer you the top free Blu-ray burner software and help you create your own Blu-ray discs from videos even protected media.

Nowadays Blu-ray is becoming more and more popular after it won the battle with HD DVD. You may need to burn Blu-ray discs for playing videos and movies in home cinema for your own entertainment or making it a special gift for your friends or families, or just for backing up your video, music and image files. Maybe you find there are many free blu-ray burner software, but which one is the best? Here I have collected several top free software for you to burn blu ray Windows 7/mac. You can choose whichever one you like.

Top free Blu-ray burner software review and download:

1. <u>ImgBurn</u>



It's quite user-friendly for its interface is clear and you can simply click "Write files/folders to disc" and then add your videos. Once you have inserted a blank BD into your computer, it will be detected by this tool automatically. You can preset your output folder by hitting "Tools"->"Settings".


Key Features:

- 1. Support Blu-ray/DVD/HD DVD/CD burning and burn Blu-ray Video discs from a BDMV/BDAV.
- 2. Own several "Modes" (Read, build, write, verify, discovery). Each one is specially designed for a different task.
- 3. A great variety of file formats are supported, covering ISO, MDS, NRG, DI, DVD, GI, IMG, BIN, CCD, CDI, CUE and PDI.

2. BurnAware



It allows you to create various types of files including digital phones, pictures, documents, archives, videos and music to Blu-ray, DVD discs and CDs. Just choose "Data disc" or "Blu-ray Disc" icon to add your files and then burn them with ease.

Key Features:


- 1. Clean and user-friendly interface with multilanguage offered.
- 2. Low CPU occupation while burning as well as keep steady burning process.
- 3. Offer a lot of advanced selections such as BOOT settings, UDF division and

versions, ISO levels and restrictions, etc.

Supported OS: latest Windows 8.1 and any version beginning from Windows XP, both 32 and 64 bits.

3. CDBurnerXP



This tool is quite personalized, you can choose to install it with several languages supported at all once. You won't see the selection for English version, but actually it's the default one. After you launch this tool, you can choose "Data disc" and then hit "OK" to continue. You will see a clear interface for you to burn Blu-ray disc. Click "Add" button to add files and then press "Burn" icon to start the burning process once you have inserted a blank BD into your computer.


Key Features:

- 1. Support Blu-Ray/HD DVD/DVD/CD burning.
- 2. Burn and create ISO files.
- 3. Multi-language interface.
- 4. Data will be verified after finishing the burning process.

4. Ashampoo Burning Studio Free



With the clear interface, you can easily figure out how to burn your Blu-ray disc with it. You can see it provides various functions, such as burning data, restoring files, coping misic and movie files to disc and even erasing your rewritable disc covered in the advanced function.

- 1. Support Blu-ray/DVD/CD burning.
- 2. Clear interface and easy to use.
- 3. Burn discs with fast speed, best quality and least amount of trouble.

5. InfraRecorder



A bit similar to the above-mentioned "CDBurnerXP", just choose "Data Disc" or "Video Disc" to begin creating your own Blu-ray Disc. You can rename your added file with this tool.

Key features:

- 1. Support Blu-ray/DVD/CD burning.
- 2. Create self-defining data, audio and blend-mode projects and record them to physical discs and disc images.

Supported OS: Windows 8, Windows 7 32-bit and 64-bit, Windows XP, Vista
